Survey of City property at Lots #22- #26: Councilman Holland made a motion to accept bid for survey by Concho Valley Land Surveying. Councilman Belcher seconded. Councilmen Crutchfield, Holland, Lindley & Belcher in favor, Councilman Matthews against; motion passed.

Consideration of purchase of road equipment: Councilman Belcher made a motion to purchase a roller for \$28,900.00 out of New Mexico with 972 hours on it (#1 in list of estimates provided to council) Councilman Crutchfield seconded.
