Irion County Contract for Assessing and Collection of Taxes. Joyce Gray, Irion County Tax Assessor-Collector, provided council the 2018 contract for approval. Councilman Taylor made a motion to accept contract as written. Councilman Belcher seconded. All in favor; motion passed.

<u>Proposed Tax Rate for 2018:</u> Joyce Gray, Irion County Tax Assessor-Collector, provided council the 2018 certified values for property tax rates. Councilman Taylor made a motion to approve the proposed tax rate .0537830/\$100 value resulting in a revenue of \$177,734.00 for the 2018 year. Councilman Matthews seconded.
