Truck and Equipment Purchase: Councilman Taylor made a motion to approve the estimate from the Goodbuy Program. Councilman Belcher seconded. All in favor; motion passed. Estimates for truck tires was reviewed. Discussion only.

**Storage Tank Maintenance:** Councilman Taylor made a motion to approve Texas Tank Service estimate. Councilman Belcher approved. All in favor; motion passed.
