<u>Public Comments:</u> (a) Business owner Chris Lee addressed the council to review extension of hours of operation and allotted parking spots per the new Ordinance #15-02. (b) Resident Johnny Wales expressed his support for council to consider and allow the new Irion County Volunteer Fire Department building be built on City of Mertzon property.

<u>Irion County Volunteer Fire Department Board's proposed site for new Volunteer Fire Department on City of Mertzon's property of Block 105, Lot 1-8:</u> Discussion only.

<u>Texas General Warranty Deed for sale of parcel of land within the City of Mertzon Park:</u> Councilman Taylor made a motion to approve the Texas General Warranty as written. Councilman Belcher seconded. All in favor; motion passed.

Irion County Public Swimming Pool water source: (a) Councilman Taylor made a motion to approve the use of the well located at the Irion County ISD's football field for the remaining 2019 summer. Councilman Crutchfield seconded. All in favor; motion passed. (b) Councilman Matthews made a motion to table discussion of long-term use of the Irion County ISD football field well and the applicable water fees. Councilman Holland seconded. All in favor; motion passed.

(a) Section 551.072 of the Texas Government Code; deliberation regarding real property, consideration to purchase property located around the Robertson well. (b) Section 551.074 of the Texas Government Code; any personnel matters that council has, consideration of employment positions for both full and part time.
