Public Comments: None.

<u>Sewer Line Replacement:</u> Councilman Matthews made a motion to approve the estimate from Fambro Construction, LLC to replace damaged sewer line in alley from 3rd street to 4th street. Councilman Crutchfield seconded. All in favor; motion passed.

Storm Water Run Off: Discussion only; no action taken.

Prior Meeting Minutes: Councilman Matthews made a motion to approve May 21, 2018, minutes with corrections. Councilman Taylor seconded. All in favor; motion passed.

Financial Documents: Councilman Crutchfield made a motion to approve all financial documents. Councilman Taylor seconded. All in favor; motion passed.

City Administrator's Report: Information presented by Administrator Benson.

- 1. Accounts payable were submitted for review and initialed by each council member.
- 2. Bank account balances were presented.
- 3. Current budgets were presented.
- 4. Road repairs will begin this week.
- 5. Summer part time employees began work today.
- 6. A payment of \$1867.00 from Travlers Insurance was received due to damages incurred from a traffic accident. The trailer has been returned to the city. Pricing for a new trailer will be provided at next council meeting.
- 7. The short set pump sent out for repair will need to be replaced. Items were approved in the budget. Pump has been ordered and will be delivered this week.
- 8. The City's Attorney is currently working on a contract to purchase water from a new well site.

Daily Operations Update: Information presented by Operations Supervisor Steve Thompson.

- 1. Water usage has substantially increased. Water level at the stand pipe has dropped from 90ft to 83ft.
- 2. Multiple taps both on water and sewer, that are not on record, have been temporally disconnected.
- 3. The new gear box for the areators has been received.
- 4. Sludge will be hauled this week to the City's land application site.
- 5. Part of the TCEQ required containments have been received and are waiting on two more.
- 6. Four meter boxes have been changed out due to leaks.
- 7. 3'D Plumbing was hired to assist in a sewer line that was damaged.
