

ORDINANCE # 1.04

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MERTZON, TEXAS REPEALING
ORDINANCE 07-06-01.**

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 07-06-01 created and placed a curfew on all persons under 17 years of age, with terms, conditions and penalties provided for therein; and

WHEREAS, The Texas legislature has passed HB 1819, referenced as Section 370.007(JUVENILE CURFEWS PROHIBITED), Texas Local Government Code, whereby a political subdivision may not impose or adopt an ordinance that imposes a curfew to regulate the movements or actions of persons younger than 18 years of age; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mertzton, in compliance with said State Law, does in all things repeal, terminate and abolish Ordinance No. 07-06-01, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MERTZON, THAT: The City of Mertzton, Texas, hereby adopts the following ordinance:

SECTION 1. REPEAL OF ORDINANCE

Ordinance No. 07-06-01, introduced April 1st, 2002 and passed on May 6th, 2002 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication by the City of Mertzton (the "effective date"), and it is accordingly so ordained.

SECTION 3. PROPER NOTICE & OPEN MEETING.

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was passed was open to the public, as required by law, and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551.
